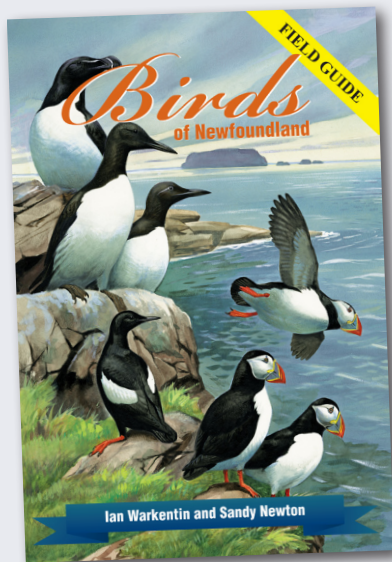


Birds of Newfoundland
